

# Mask Wearing/Illness

As of February 28<sup>th</sup>, the Government of Saskatchewan declared that masks are no longer mandatory. As a school division, and as Glen Elm Staff, we are strongly recommending continued mask use by staff and students. Proper mask use is an important layer of protection and we will continue to supply medical grade masks for students and staff if needed. We will also continue to maintain enhanced cleaning protocols in all schools, buildings and buses; encourage regular self-testing at home; and remind staff and students to remain diligent in monitoring any symptoms and if they are experiencing mild, cold-like symptoms, including cough, sore throat, headache, sneezing without fever, it is recommended to stay home, care for symptoms, and use rapid antigen testing. In saying that, we continue to ask for your help in keeping your child/ren home if they are not feeling well. Thank you for your ongoing support in keeping Glen Elm School staff and students as safe as possible.

With the lifting of restrictions, we can resume our field trips, extra-curricular activities, and mix cohorts for educational purposes. We are excited to get back into starting up teams (basketball), SRC, GSA, and fingers crossed that we will be able to compete in a track and field meet this year!
